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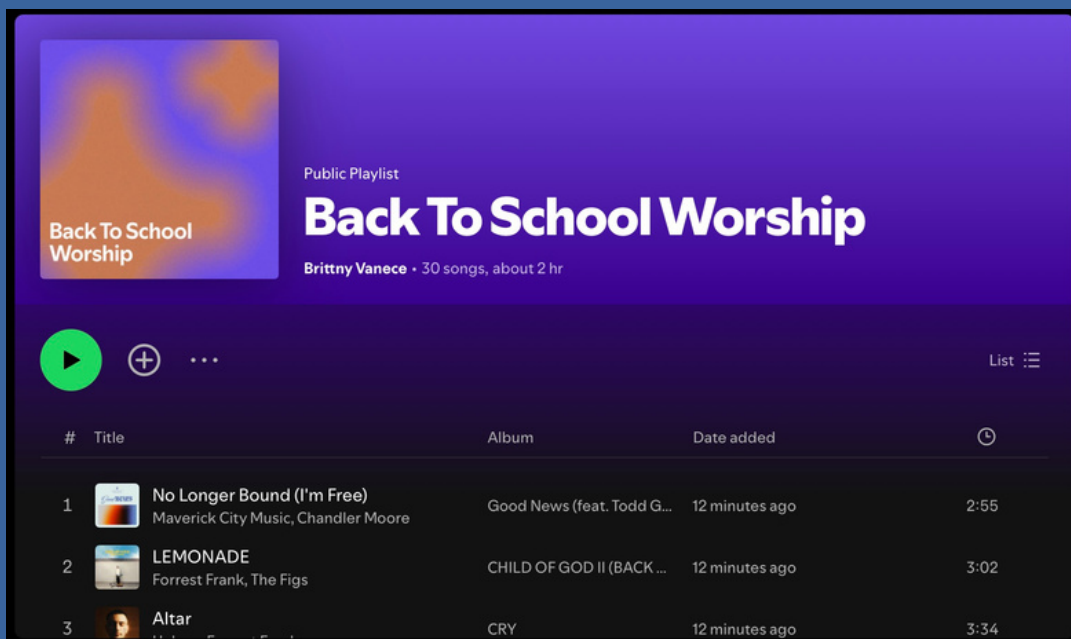

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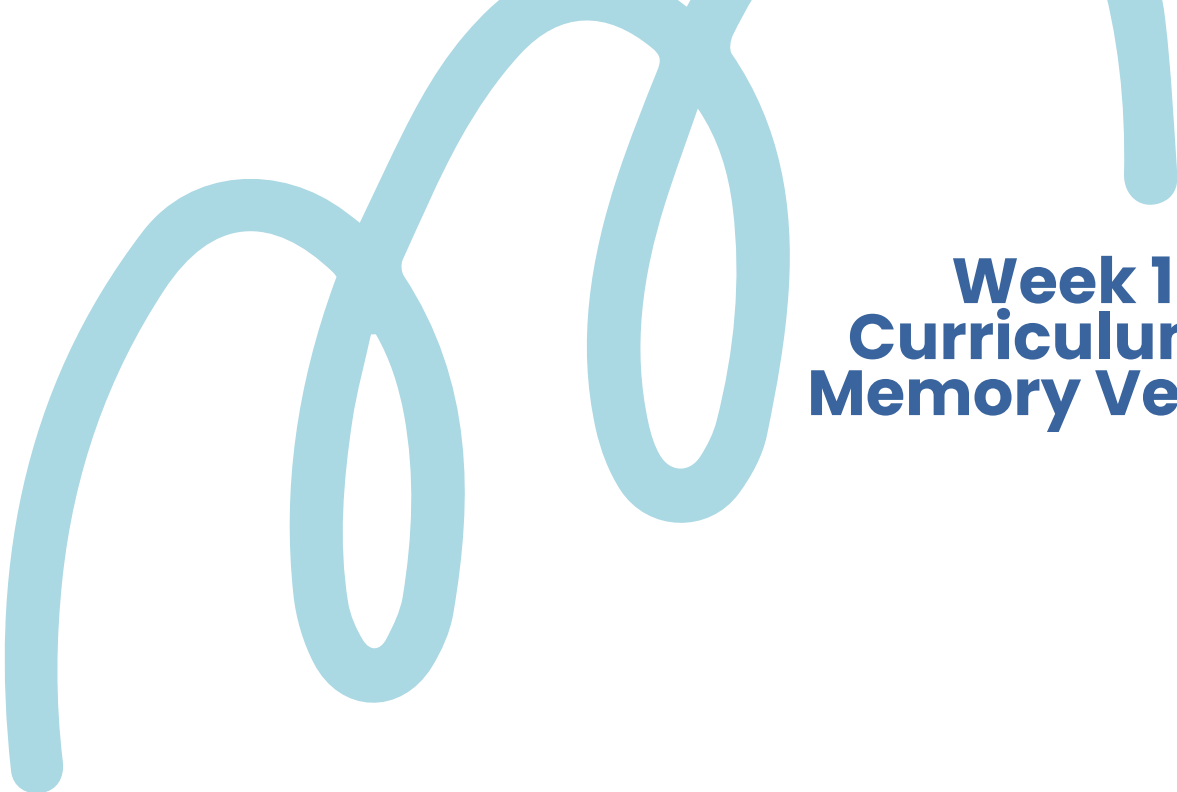
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Week 1 Curriculum + Memory Verses

This Week at a Glance

Series: Kingdom Builders | I Am Called to Build God's Kingdom

Bible Story | Jesus Washes the Disciples' Feet | John 13:1–17

Memory Verse | "For we are God's fellow workers." **1 Corinthians 3:9**

Character Trait | **Humility** | Humility means helping others with a joyful heart, even when no one is watching.

Family Devotional

Read Together

John 13:1–17

Ask your child to imagine being one of the disciples sitting at the table. How would they have felt when Jesus knelt down and began washing their feet?

Explain that Jesus wasn't just cleaning dirty feet. He was teaching His followers that the greatest leaders are willing to serve others with love.

Remind your child that every act of kindness, no matter how small, reflects the heart of Jesus.



Family Discussion Questions

Use these questions during dinner, bedtime, or while driving together.

1. Why do you think Jesus washed His disciples' feet?
2. Why was Peter surprised?
3. What does humility mean?
4. Who serves our family every day?
5. How can we thank those people?
6. What is one way you can serve at school?
7. How can our family serve someone together this week?
8. What do you think Jesus wants us to learn from today's story?

Family Prayer

Pray together each evening.

Heavenly Father, thank You for sending Jesus to show us what true love looks like. Help our family become known for serving others with joyful hearts. Open our eyes to notice people who need encouragement, kindness, and help. Teach us to love without expecting anything in return, just as Jesus loved us. May our lives point others to You. In Jesus' name, Amen.



Family Kingdom Builder Challenge

Complete one challenge each day.

Monday | Help clean a room without being asked.

Tuesday | Write a thank-you note to someone who serves you.
Examples: Teacher, Coach, Bus driver, Pastor, Police officer

Wednesday | Pray together for someone who is sick or discouraged.

Thursday | Bake cookies or prepare a small treat for a neighbor.

Friday | Serve someone secretly without telling anyone.

Saturday | Choose one family service project.

Ideas include:

- Pick up litter in your neighborhood.
- Donate toys or clothing.
- Deliver groceries to an elderly neighbor.
- Assemble blessing bags for people experiencing homelessness.
- Volunteer at a local outreach ministry.

Sunday | Share stories during dinner about how each family member served someone during the week. Celebrate every act of kindness.



Family Conversation Starters

These short prompts can be used anytime throughout the week.

Who helped you today?

Who did you help today?

Was it easy or difficult to serve someone?

How did serving make you feel?

How do you think it made the other person feel?

What do you think Jesus would do in that situation?



Family Scripture Reading Plan

Monday | John 13:1–5 | Focus: Jesus chose to serve.

Tuesday | John 13:12–17 | Focus: Follow Jesus' example.

Wednesday | Mark 10:45 | Focus: Jesus came to serve.

Thursday | Philippians 2:3–5 | Focus: Put others first.

Friday | Galatians 5:13 | Focus: Serve one another in love.

Saturday | Colossians 3:23 | Focus: Work for the Lord.

Sunday | Matthew 20:26–28 | Focus: Greatness through serving.



Parent Encouragement

One of the greatest gifts you can give your child is the opportunity to see service modeled consistently at home. Children learn humility by watching humble parents.

Invite your child into everyday opportunities to serve alongside you:

- Folding laundry
- Preparing dinner
- Writing encouragement cards
- Helping a neighbor
- Serving at church
- Cleaning together

These ordinary moments become extraordinary discipleship opportunities.

Remember, your example often teaches louder than your words.

- K-5th Grade: Gummies + water

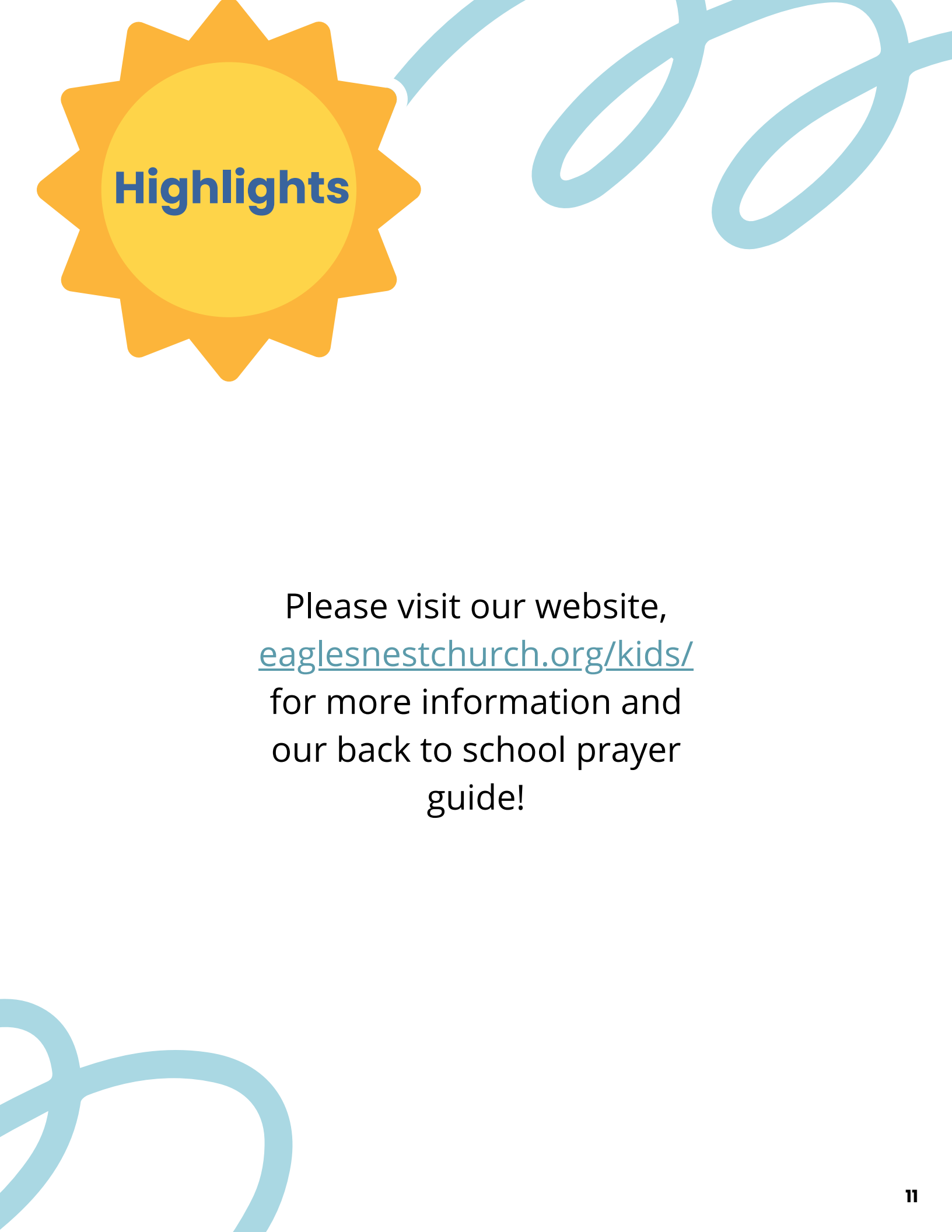
